

## Repetition for the Soul

These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel across the Jordan in the wilderness, in the Arabah opposite Suph, between Paran and Tophel and Laban and Hazereth and Dizahab. **2** It is eleven days' *journey* from Horeb by the way of Mount Seir to Kadesh-barnea. **3** In the fortieth year, on the first *day* of the eleventh month, Moses spoke to the children of Israel, according to all that the Lord had commanded him *to give* to them... Deuteronomy 1:1-3

1. Read Deuteronomy chapter 1.
2. As you read this chapter, what do you find challenging? Why?
3. When did Moses speak these things? (v. 3) Why is this significant?
4. Why did Moses speak these things? (v. 3) Why is this significant?
5. Two things are happening in this passage: 1.) Moses is re-speaking the law because it had been 40 years since He originally received it and shared it with the people. 2.) Moses is speaking these things because God commanded Him to. How many times have God's people forgotten what He said and needed a reminder throughout scripture? How often does this happen today? How often does it happen to you?
6. What are some of the important truths you believe the up-and-coming generation has forgotten? What are some that you have?
