4. Read Romans chapter four. How does this relate?

5. Romans 4 speaks of justification through faith and not through the law. Have you come to the place in your walk that it is only through the blood of Jesus that you are credited as being righteous?

6. All desire to be righteous. The problem is when we try in our own strength we fail miserably. The ONLY hope we have is faith in Jesus and relying on His strength. In order to do this we need to recognize the need of a savior in our lives. Have you realized you are in need of a savior?
